Also, for whatever reason, the postal mail does not seem to be exactly punctual. Since June 22, 2020, I have sent 781 letters to lawyers with a request for a human rights lawyer. Most of the letters reach their destinations, and many lawyers respond with their commentaries. But some of my letters are returning with notes “insufficient address” or “not deliverable as addressed”. Fair enough, but for the last month, of all the returned 7 have been totally opened. I am concerned about the spectrum of potential disruptions – either by the government initiative, or, more probably, by the nosiness or ineptitude of postal workers. Therefore, if you received this letter with the request for a human rights lawyer, please date and sign the current one-page “return receipt” letter and send back to me in the enclosed self-addressed envelope.
